Art	Students will be formally assessed during one whole lesson across a range of subject specific skills.	N/A
Dance	The assessment will last one hour and require the pupils to work in small groups and combine the key skills from all previous lessons that term into one dance.	No additional preparation beyond the attendance of scheduled lessons is required.
