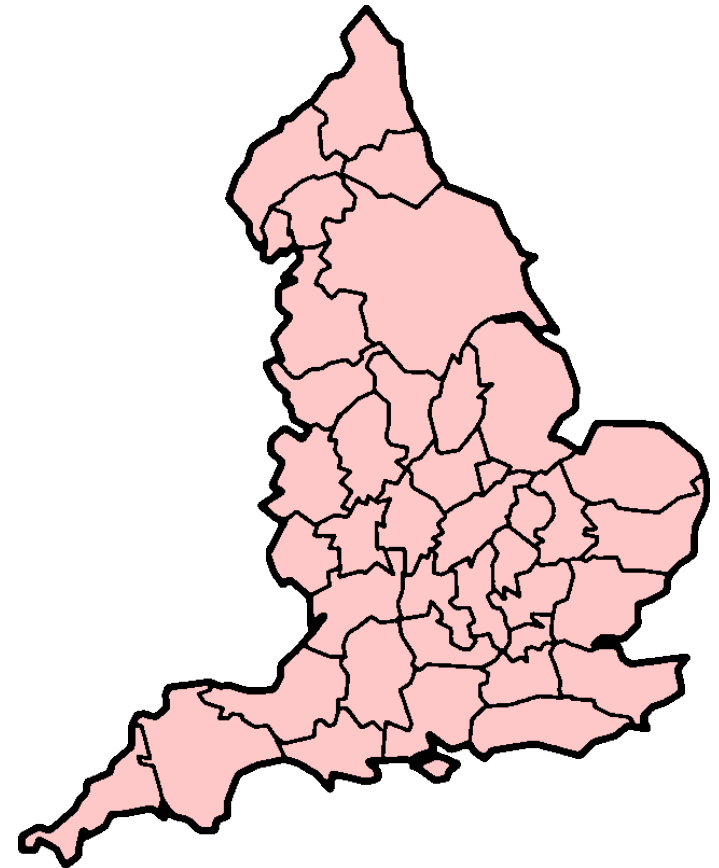

Year 8 Assessment week overview

Subject	Overview of assessment	Useful revision websites/guidance
Art	Students will be formally assessed during one whole lesson across a range of subject specific skills.	N/A
Dance	The assessment will last one hour and require the pupils to work in small groups and combine the key skills from all previous lessons that term into one dance.	No additional preparation beyond the attendance of scheduled lessons is required.
Drama	The assessment will last one hour and students will be grouped and create a performance based around a randomly (by the class) set of stimuli.	No additional preparation beyond the attendance of scheduled lessons is required.
Design and Technology	A one hour test based on the whole range of skills and knowledge covered since the start of Year 7.	Please use class notes and guidance from your teacher.
English	The assessment will compare the way two poets present their attitudes towards World War One. Teachers will assess each student's ability to analyse the language and structure of each poem and to compare their similarities and differences.	Students will need to revise the War poems they have studied in class in order to prepare for a comparison essay.
French	A reading paper lasting 20 minutes and a writing paper 26 mins based on the Unit 6 of the Click 1 star textbook.	Please use class notes, vocabulary lists from the text books and www.linquascopie.com username: rejsatesco and password: rejsatemi.
Geography	A 30 minute test requiring students to write an essay about global warming, causes, effects and responses.	Please use class notes and guidance from your teacher.
History	A 30 minute test based on interpreting source material on the English Civil War.	Please use class notes and guidance from your teacher.
ICT	A 30 minute test on websites, html and designations.	Please use class notes and guidance from your teacher.
Mathematics	The test will last one hour long and is an example of one of the Reigate School Maths Challenges. It will cover all aspects of numeracy for example, Equations, Substitution and Angles.	Students can use mymaths as well as their class notes.
Music	Students will be grouped and create a composition based on the elements of African Music or Hooks and Riffs depending on which group you are in. Students will be assessed on their ability to create a piece of music as a group.	No additional preparation beyond the attendance of scheduled lessons is required.
PE	The assessment will consist of warm-ups, skills based practices in isolation and then a competitive match play situation, linked to the GCSE criteria outlined in the Edexcel specification and which group they are in.	All students should seek guidance from their teachers.
Subject	Overview of assessment	Useful revision websites/guidance
RE	Several short questions followed by a 12 mark extended question based on content covered since Year 7 for which you will have 30 minutes.	Please use class notes and guidance from your teacher.
Science	A 30 minute test based on whichever particular unit the student has been learning about since September.	Please read through classwork, use the summary sheet issued to make notes and seek guidance from your teacher.
Spanish	Listening test lasting 30 minutes and a 10 minute speaking test on Unit 3 of the Zoom 1 textbook.	Please use class notes, vocabulary lists from the text books and www.linquascopie.com username: rejsatesco and password: rejsatemi.

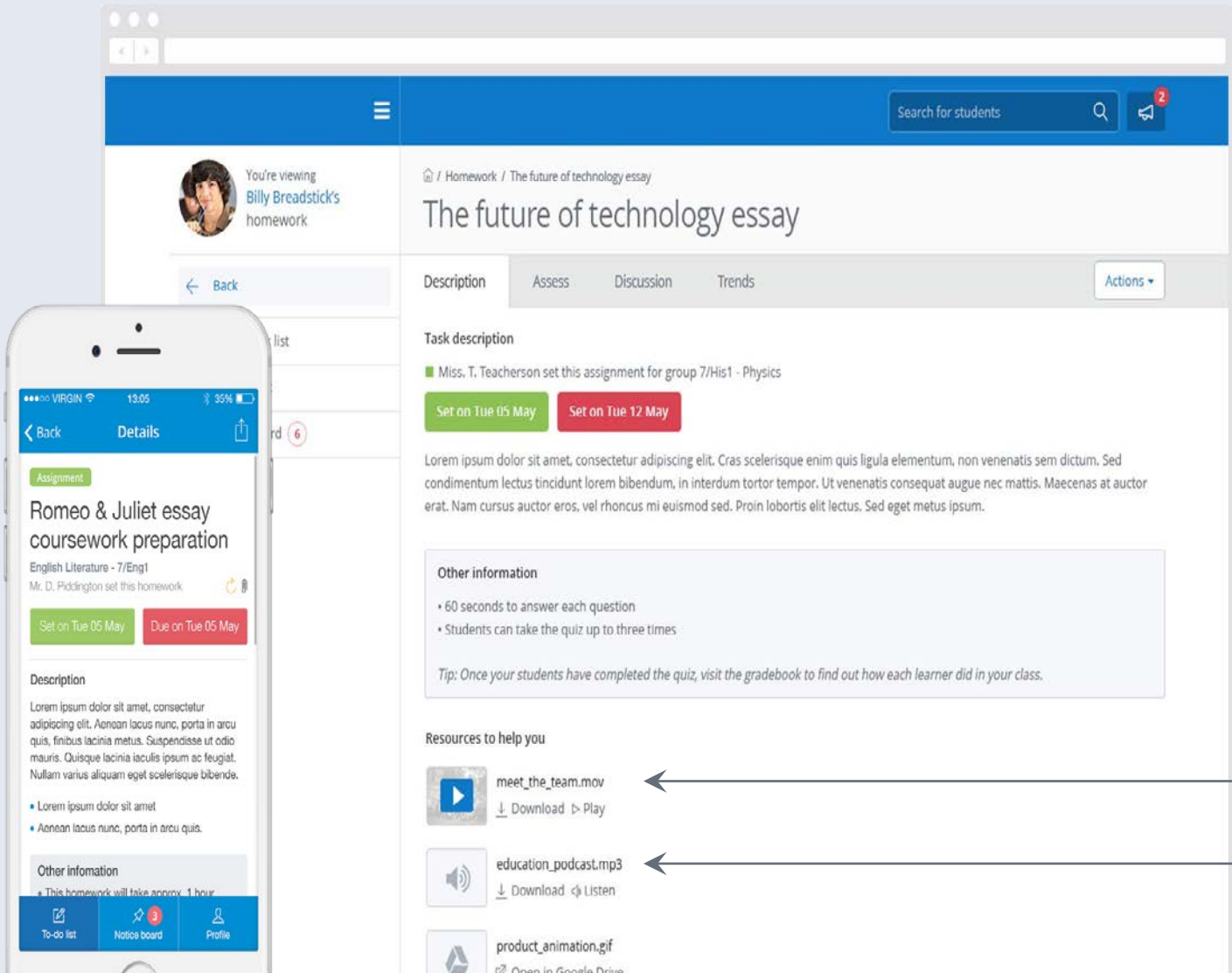

Tutor group awards

Year 7 – 11 Tutor groups
