## COLLEGE TASTER DAYS

On Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July, Year 10 went on a taster day to Reigate College. Before going to the college, we selected our subjects and activities that interested us. We were able to choose three options some of which included Business Studies, Art, English, Psychology and Media Studies. Reigate College offered a mix of practical and academic subjects. An academic subject such as Business Studies involved designing a fruit juice. This meant creating a design for a bottle of juice, then calculating the profit we would make from the product afterwards. A more practical subject such as Art included creating self-portraits using wire followed by looking at the artwork of college students. Our timetable started at 9:30am with a short welcome from the college staff before our sessions at 10am. Our three sessions lasted an hour each with a break and lunch in between.

On Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July, Year 10 also went to East Surrey College where unlike Reigate College we had two options instead of three. We found that East Surrey College offered more practical sessions. These included Hairdressing, Travel and Tourism, Applied Science and Public Services. These practical sessions involved more hands on tasks, for example in Hairdressing, the Year 10s enjoyed washing and styling each other's hair, whereas in Applied Science, the Year 10s used the apparatus available to look at cell samples under a microscope. Our sessions lasted two hours each giving us the opportunity to focus on our chosen options in detail.

The whole of Year 10 including us thoroughly enjoyed our visit to both colleges. Our college experience will be useful when choosing our college options during Year 11. The opportunity to visit both colleges in our local area has given us a better understanding of what courses the colleges have to offer and what a typical college day would be like.

**BUS TIMETABLE CHANGES FROM SEPTEMBER**

**Blenheim High School**

Service E5 (Quality Line) - Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the later finish to the school day.

**Imberhorne School**

Service 409 (Southdown) - due to very low usage this service will no longer call at Imberhorne School.

**Oakwood School**

Service 424 (Southdown) - Afternoon journey towards Smallfield and Burstow will no longer operate into the school grounds. Pick up will be from The Kings Head bus stop in Smallfield Road at 15:16.

**Oxted School**

Service 357 (Southdown) - Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the earlier finish in the school day.

Service 410 (Southdown) - The afternoon journey from the school at 15:30 operating to Godstone Green, Bletchingley and Redhill will now depart from Station Road East at 15:29.

Service 594/595 ( Southdown) - All journeys via Limsfield Chart will operate in a one-way loop Kent Hatch Road via Moorhouse Road, Tally Road, serve bus stop opposite the Carpenters Arms, Tally Road, Ridlands Rise, Stoneleigh Road, Moorhouse Road, Kent Hatch Road. Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the earlier finish in the school day.

Service 609 (Southdown) - This service has been revised to operate between Lingfield Racecourse and Ray Lane via Station Road, Crowhurst Road and Lingfield Common Road. It will no longer operate to/from Lingfield War Memorial and Saxby's Lane. Pupils from these locations can use revised service 694.

Service 610 (Southdown) - Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the earlier finish in the school day. Afternoon service will continue to Felbridge if requested by passengers already on board.

Service 694 (Southdown) - This service will start from Lingfield War Memorial and operate via Church Road and Saxby's Lane to Crowhurst Road morning and afternoons. Passengers from Lingfield Common Road can use revised service 609. Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the earlier finish in the school day.

Service 695 (Southdown) - Revised afternoon timetable to accommodate the earlier finish in the school day.

**Sackville School**

Service 236/646 (Southdown) - All journeys will operate as service 236 and operate through East Grinstead Town Centre.

**St Bede's Redhill & Reigate College**

Service 324 (Southdown) - In Horley the route has been revised to operate from Horley Air Balloon via Vicarage Lane to Horley Row. New route 622 will serve Hookwood, Reigate Road, Mill Lane and Lee Street. Whitebushes will be served on both the morning and afternoon journeys.

**St Bede's Redhill, Reigate College & Reigate School**

Service 622 (Southdown) Crawley-Hookwood-Westvale Park-Dovers Green-Woodhatch-Meadvale-Reigate-St Bede's School

New route providing a replacement for service 324 in Hookwood, Reigate Road, Mill Lane and Lee Street. This service will operate through the new Westvale Park development in Horley to provide transport links to Reigate School, Reigate College and St Bede's School.

Service 424 – revised route which no longer operates via the Timperley Gardens area of Redhill or Whitebushes. Passengers in Whitebushes can use Metrobus service 430 to Woodhatch Road. Passengers from Timperley Gardens can use Southdown service 357 into at 07:23 which continues to Reigate School as service 422 for 07:40 or catch 357 to Redhill 07:30 and change to Southdown service 424 to Woodhatch arrive 0816.

# PARENTAL PORTAL - SLG

## What is the Parental Portal (SIMS Learning Gateway)?

SIMS Learning Gateway (SLG) is a system that allows parents/carers to have access to information that we keep about their children.

## What information can I access?

Currently SLG allows you to see information about your child's attendance, assessments, conduct log, which includes achievement and behaviour management, as well as their timetable. SLG uses real-time data, so the information is always current. Reigate School takes electronic registers in morning registration and in all five lessons.

## Can I see whether my child has arrived in school?

Our tutors finish their morning registers by 9:05am. You will be able to log in to SLG at 9:05am to see whether your child has been marked as present. However, there are several reasons why the register may be late going into the SIMS system (for example, a tutor may not be in school so the register may initially be done on paper by a cover supervisor). If you notice that your child is not registered, please wait and check after 9.30am before contacting the school.

## What if I spot inaccuracies in the information?

Data integrity is important to us. While we endeavour to make sure that all of our data is accurate, we realise that mistakes are possible.

## Who gets access to this information?

We launched SLG for all children, parents and carers in 2016. We sent out usernames and passwords to all parents and carers who we have registered as the primary point of contact for each child. ## Parental Portal (SIMS Learning Gateway) - Quick Start Guide

The SLG is accessed using a web browser and by entering the details that have been provided to you by the school. The account will give you access to information relating to any children that you have at Reigate School.

## Finding Information on the SLG

Once logged in you should click on the **Parents/Carers** tab at the top of the page. You will then see the home page of the SLG Parent Site containing current SLG notices. On the left hand side of the screen are several sections that will be of interest.

**My Account Page** – it is advised that you visit this page the first time you log in and change your password to something more memorable. If you forget your password you will need to contact [slghelpdesk@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:slghelpdesk@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk) to request it to be reset.

**My Children Dashboard** – here you will find the main information about your child or children. In the main part of the page you will see headline information including attendance.

At the bottom of the page under **My Children Links** you will find three sections:

**Student Dashboard** – here you will find information regarding behaviour, achievements and timetable.

**View Reports** – this is where progress reports can be found. Click on the arrow next to the current academic year and a list of available reports will be displayed. Please note you will be unable to view reports when using a smartphone or iPhone as the mobile view doesn't support this.

**Data Collection Sheet** – Use this section of the SLG to check and update the information that we hold, including home address and home/mobile/work telephone numbers and email addresses. Changes are then submitted electronically and there is no need to telephone the school to advise us of those changes.
