E-SAFETY PRESENTATION AND PARENT FORUM

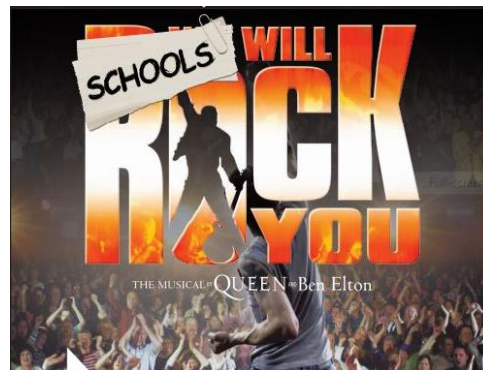
