## What's a work permit?

It just means that your employer has registered you with the Child Employment Office

## w many hours can you work?

'm between 13 and 14 so....
HOOL DAYS I can work up to two hours a day (outside school f course!!)
urdays I can work up to 5 hours

more than 12 hours - between 7am \& 7pm
I holidays I can work up to 5 hours a day and up to

o have at least two consecutive weeks holiday every year employment - to make sure I get some time off.

1 time and on Sundays, on Saturdays I can only work 2 hours a olidays I can work 8 hours a day and I can work up to 8 hours. a day and up to 35 hours a week.

The only big deal is that no-one is allowed to work before 7 am and after 7 pm any day of the week.

## Is it really that easy?

As long as the hours are ok, your parents are happy with it, and your school agrees, then you're in business!

Just remember to make sure you find out about your pay and talk it over with your parents. You don't want to get ripped off!

## Can I be stopped from working?

YES! - Your employer will be told to end your job if...
...you don't attend school
...you are late for school (because of your job)
...your education or health suffers.

## Don't be a statistic!

Have fun at work, enjoy your job. It is part of your education for life. But most of all take care... and if you're asked to do anything outside your job expectation, speak to your parents.
