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| Increased attainment and progress in English & Maths for children who were performing lower than expected in KS2. |

| <p>Year 7 Enhanced English Additional English & Literacy lessons are provided for selected children based on data from KS2 assessments. This amounts to 3 lessons per fortnight per group in a small group session. Sessions are delivered by Intervention Tutors, using specific schemes of work tailored to literacy.</p> | <p>Small group tuition programmes are identified by the EEF to have an impact of +4 months on a child's progress. The Enhanced Learning group further supports mastery learning by continually revisiting key content and skills until they are mastered, which the EEF identify as having an impact of +5 months on a child's progress.</p> | <p>Cost - £4,500 incl. misc resources The programme was delivered intensively throughout the year. Children who attended school regularly made excellent progress in exit tests and 39% of children were predicted a Grade 4 in English by the end of the academic year. Furthermore, 78% of children demonstrated an accelerated improvement in their reading age over the course of the year, with 22% making an improvement of over 2 years. Enhanced English will continue in 2019-2020; however, a new programme will be followed called the Hackney LIT programme to improve outcomes even further.</p> |
| <p>Year 7 Enhanced Maths Additional Maths lessons are provided for selected children based on data from KS2 assessments. This amounts to 3 lessons per fortnight. Sessions are delivered by Maths teachers, using specific schemes of work tailored to key Maths skills.</p> | <p>Small group tuition programmes are identified by the EEF to have an impact of +4 months on a child's progress. The Enhanced Maths group further supports mastery learning by continually revisiting key content and skills until they are mastered, which the EEF identify as having an impact of +5 months on a child's progress.</p> | <p>Cost - £10,013 incl. misc resources The programme was timetabled and delivered consistently throughout the year. Children who attended school regularly made excellent progress in exit tests; 77% of children were predicted a Grade 3 in Maths by the end of the academic year. Furthermore, 30% were predicted a Grade 4 in Maths. Enhanced Maths will continue in 2019-2020.</p> |
| <p>Catch Up Literacy & Numeracy 1:1 Support Trained intervention tutors work on a 1:1 basis with children who have been identified based on data from KS2 assessments, and later from information</p> | <p>1:1 tuition programmes are identified by the EEF to have an impact of +5 months on a child's progress. Children are also receiving individualised, immediate feedback on</p> | <p>Cost - £200 Catch Up Numeracy had significant success with the small number of children that were worked with. | <p>Lexia Online Software Lexia is an online software programme that provides differentiated literacy instruction for children through personalized learning in the six areas of reading instruction, targeting skill gaps as they emerge, and providing teachers with the data and student-specific resources to support children. Children are identified through data from KS2 assessments, as well as internal reading age tests. Children complete this online learning in both Enhanced English lessons, as well as library lessons.</p> | <p>Reading comprehension strategies are identified by the EEF to have an impact of +6 months on a child's progress. By targeting the specific area for development at an individualised pace, children are getting a bespoke intervention programme. This is further supported by 1:1 intervention when the data identifies a child is "struggling" on a particular area of reading instruction. 1:1 tuition is identified by the EEF to have an impact of +5 months on a child's progress, while the study of phonics, which is a key element of the Lexia programme, has an impact of +4 months on a child's progress.</p> | <p>Cost - £1,221 Lexia was delivered once per fortnight, as part of the Enhanced English programme, as well as once per fortnight in library lessons, which contributed to the outcomes as per Enhanced English above. Lexia will continue in 2019-2020, using an improved version of the programme called <i>Lexia PowerUp</i></p> |
| <p>Study Skills Zone – "Blast Off" Year 7 Catch Up children participate in the "Blast Off" session at the beginning of Year 7, which focuses on developing a positive mind-set and study habits in preparation for the rigours of KS3. It develops self-confidence in children and supports them with developing independent study habits that are necessary for secondary school education. Children undertake this in September as part of a whole-group workshop delivered by experienced and trained Study Skills mentors.</p> | <p>Introducing children to the different learning styles and how to study and learn in secondary school is a key aspect of metacognition, which the EEF recognises as having an impact of +7 months on a child's progress. The delivery of the programme is in a fun and engaging way, which supports motivating and enthusing children to become active learners in lessons.</p> | <p>Cost - £795 The study skills programme was an excellent success, with children demonstrating enthusiasm and motivation in the session, as well as engagement and motivation in lessons throughout the year. The "Blast Off" programme will be delivered again to Catch Up children in 2019-2020. However, this will be delivered to the entire cohort of Year 7 children and will not come from the Catch Up Premium budget.</p> |
