



HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The main aim of the school is: to help children realise their academic, personal and social potential

The following statements demonstrate those values that are expected at Reigate School. These are Respect, Kindness, Resilience, Curiosity and Friendship. These values will be reinforced in lessons, in the Personal, Social and Health Education programme, in school assemblies and in all extra-curricular and social activities in Reigate School.

- **Respect** We will respect the beliefs, cultures and opinions of others.
- **Kindness** We will be generous and considerate.
- **Resilience** We will work hard, persevere and bounce back when something difficult happens.
- **Curiosity** We will recognise the value of academic achievement. We will seek challenge and be curious about our learning.
- Friendship We will build relationships based on mutual esteem, trust and goodwill.

We, at Reigate School, share your determination for your child to exploit his or her talents and potential to the full in the coming years. This can be achieved, especially if school, parents/carers and children work closely together with each aware of their rights and responsibilities. If, from the outset, we establish a clear framework of agreed behaviour and duties, we will see the results in solid progress each year.

The Parents and Carers

I agree to:

- see that my child attends school regularly and punctually with appropriate equipment;
- support my child in homework and coursework;
- communicate with the school about any problems or concerns that might affect my child's work or behaviour in school;
- respond to school communications where necessary;
- ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform;
- support the school to ensure that my child behaves in an acceptable, positive and courteous manner to staff and children;
- accept school sanctions should my child fail to conform to required standards as detailed above;
- attend Parents' and Carers' Evenings and discussions about my child's progress.

The Child

I will:

- attend school regularly and on time with appropriate equipment;
- complete my homework and classwork as well as I can and do it on time;
- wear the correct school uniform and be tidy in my appearance;
- behave in a polite and helpful manner to adults and children, conforming to the school's required standards both in school and between home and school.

The School

Reigate School will:

- contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- provide a balanced curriculum which meets children's individual needs;
- set appropriate homework that is marked regularly;
- discuss with parents/carers any problems or concerns that might affect their child's work or behaviour in school;
- provide regular communication to parents/carers in the form of Parents' and Carers' evenings and reports;
- keep parents/carers informed of school activities through the Head of School's newsletters and letters home:
- be open and welcoming to parents/carers.
