I would like to send my sincerest congratulations to Reigate School for your wonderful production of Hamlet as part of the Spring 22 Shakespeare Schools Festival. It was a brilliant evening of theatre, and I'd like to talk about a few elements that really shone.

You captured the audience's imagination from the start with your striking stage pictures that transported us into the castle of Elsinore. Your well production elements including fantastic costumes also helped to set the scene. The beautiful lighting design by Dylan Cross added to the atmosphere of the play and created an eerie sense of foreboding throughout.

I particularly loved the play within a play, it felt like we were inside the king's mind, witnessing the machinations of his guilty conscience. The cast clearly had a really solid understanding and command of the language as they gave beautiful delivery of Shakespeare's words and superbly handled the complex emotions and intense drama of the play. Your use of physicality intensified the action and highlighted your collaborative performance.

The story was clear and engaging for the audience especially as each member of the cast had strong characterisation and mastered the language with precision. You delivered your lines with passion and you were able to convey the complexities of the characters and the story.

Throughout the whole day, you displayed an impressive level of maturity which completely shone through in your full performances. I want to commend the professionalism you showed both on and off stage.

Thank you for a striking, elegant, and atmospheric Hamlet brought to life by a clear and confident ensemble.

Staging a Shakespeare play in these changing times takes extra courage, tenacity, and creativity. You should be incredibly proud of what you and your teachers have achieved.


