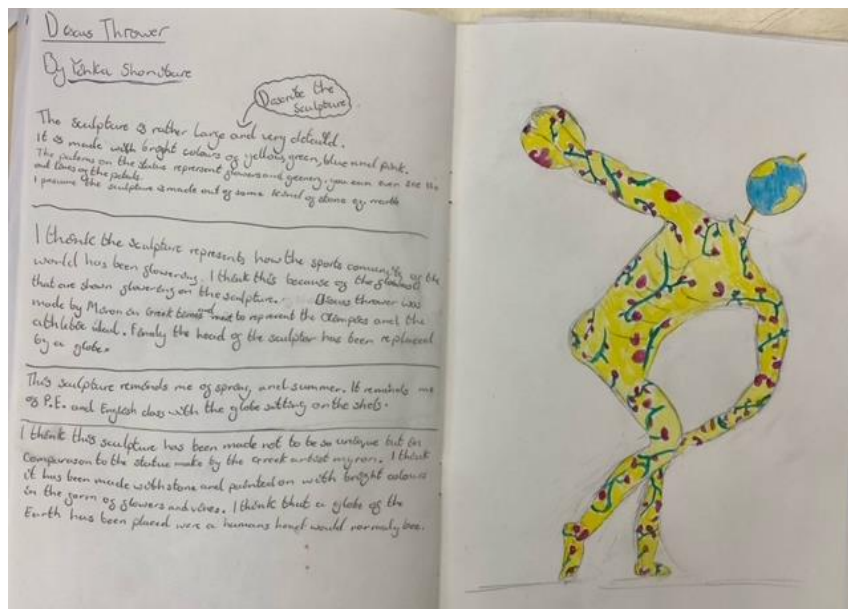



U15's Girls Rugby National Cup Final - Sunday 1st May - Old Reigatians vs Cheltenham North @ Sixways Stadium in Worcester

The following girls from Reigate School are part of the all-conquering U15 Old Reigatians RFC squad which has been so successful in a National Cup run this season: Elsa Lenihan, Elsie Parsons, Ella Critchlow, Lily Britton, Lily Woodhams, Rose Lacey, Eleni Davarias, Jesse Parker, Zoe Smith, Robyn Rooney, Imogen Wheeler, Emily Campbell and Izzie Sheehan.



The girls were involved in a classic encounter in the final against a strong physical side from Cheltenham North RFC. The game began with nervous exchanges, as both teams began with some big tackles flying in, setting the tone for strong defensive displays from both sides.

Old Reigatians went into a lead with a try from the centre midway through the first half. This was a fair reflection of play as they had a lot of possession in the opposition half, Elsa Lenihan in particular broke through the gain line and was often able to offload the ball. Cheltenham North came back strong, with large amounts of possession in the second half. Old Reigatians found it difficult to get out of their own half and spent long periods defending as a unit. Ella Critchlow was a big influence at number 8, she made numerous big tackles and was often first to the breakdown at the ruck. Eventually pressure told and the opposition scored two tries in the last 10 minutes to go into a 10-5 lead. Cheltenham North's own number 8 was a quick powerful individual who finally broke through with some devastating runs as all the player's started to fatigue. With no time left on the clock, Old Reigatians had one last attack, all or nothing, and our very own Lily Woodhams crossed the line to score with an excellent finish under intense pressure, something I'm told Lily has done all season with her outstanding pace on the wing.

The game was tied at 10-10, but with time up the game was decided on which team had scored first (unfortunately there was no extra time possible), meaning Old Reigatians were crowned National Champions! What an amazing effort from all the girls. They had great support on the day in the stadium, but also many watched via a live feed on YouTube.
