Year 9 – Simon Bland from Reigate and Banstead Borough Council

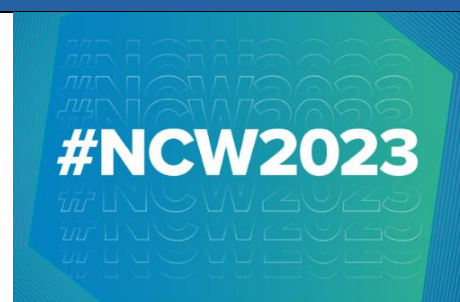

On Monday 6th March 2023, a group of our Year 11s visited Selwyn College at the University of Cambridge in order to experience what it is like to study at the university. On arrival, we had an introduction to Oxbridge talk where the children learned about the collegiate nature of the university, the subjects taught and the application process. The children were then taken on a tour of the college by current Cambridge students, where they visited the chapel, student accommodation, library and common room, before heading for lunch in the historic college hall.

After lunch, we walked into the centre of Cambridge (via Kings College) to visit the University's Whipple Museum (of the History of Science). There the children had the opportunity to explore many artefacts including one of William Herschel's telescopes and some amazing 19th century anatomical models made of papier-mâché! Before heading home there was just time for a quick Q&A session, where our children did themselves proud by asking some excellent questions.

Well done to all our Year 11s on the visit – you were an absolute pleasure and excellent ambassadors for our school.

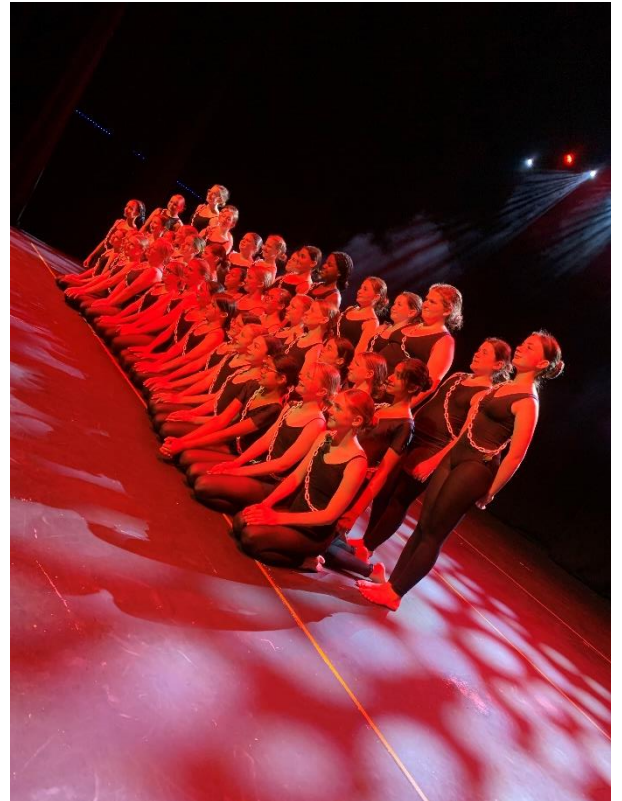

The competition is open to all ages and all artwork should use Reigate Tunnel as the focal point. An exhibition will be held in Reigate Tunnel from June to September 2023.

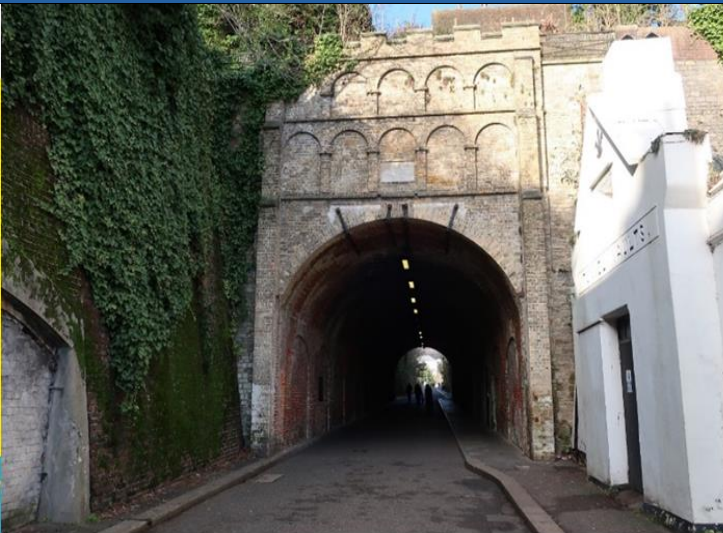

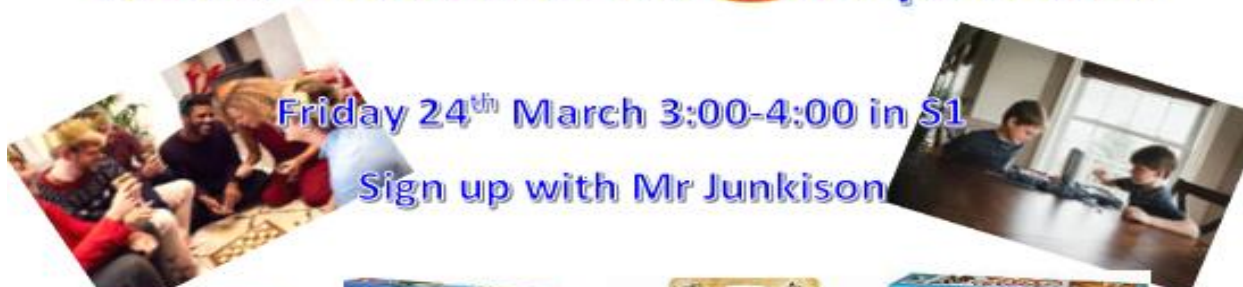

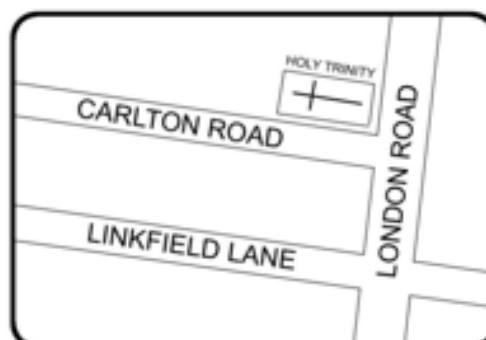
