The competition is open to all ages and all artwork should use Reigate Tunnel as the focal point. An exhibition will be held in Reigate Tunnel from June to September 2023.

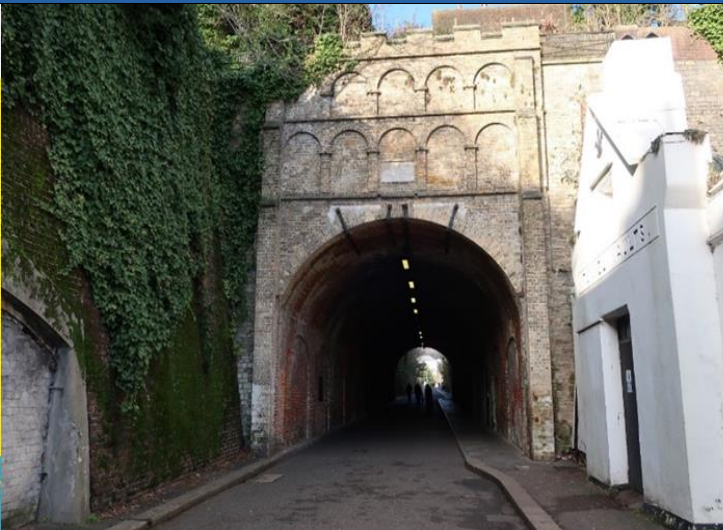
Adam's Gallery will be judging the different categories and winners will be announced in July.
