ATTENDANCE

Attendance matters because:

- Children with good attendance achieve more at school.
- Children who miss school miss out on their right to a full education.
- Time off disrupts learning for your child and also the rest of the class.
- Persistent absence (defined by the government as a child who misses more than 10%) could lead to court action including fines.
- Attendance and late arrivals to school are requested by all colleges of further education as a routine part of their admission criteria.

Attendance	Days missed per Year	Likely effect
96%-100%	0-7	Good attendance gives your child every chance of being a successful learner, progress is made, good attendance is rewarded.
92%– 95.9%	8-15	You should try to improve your child's attendance to make sure they have the best possible chance of success at school.
90% - 91.9%	16-19	Your child's attendance is dangerously close to falling to a level that stops them making progress at school.
Below 90%	20 or more	Your child is considered a persistent absentee. Their poor attendance is putting them at serious risk of underachieving at school.
