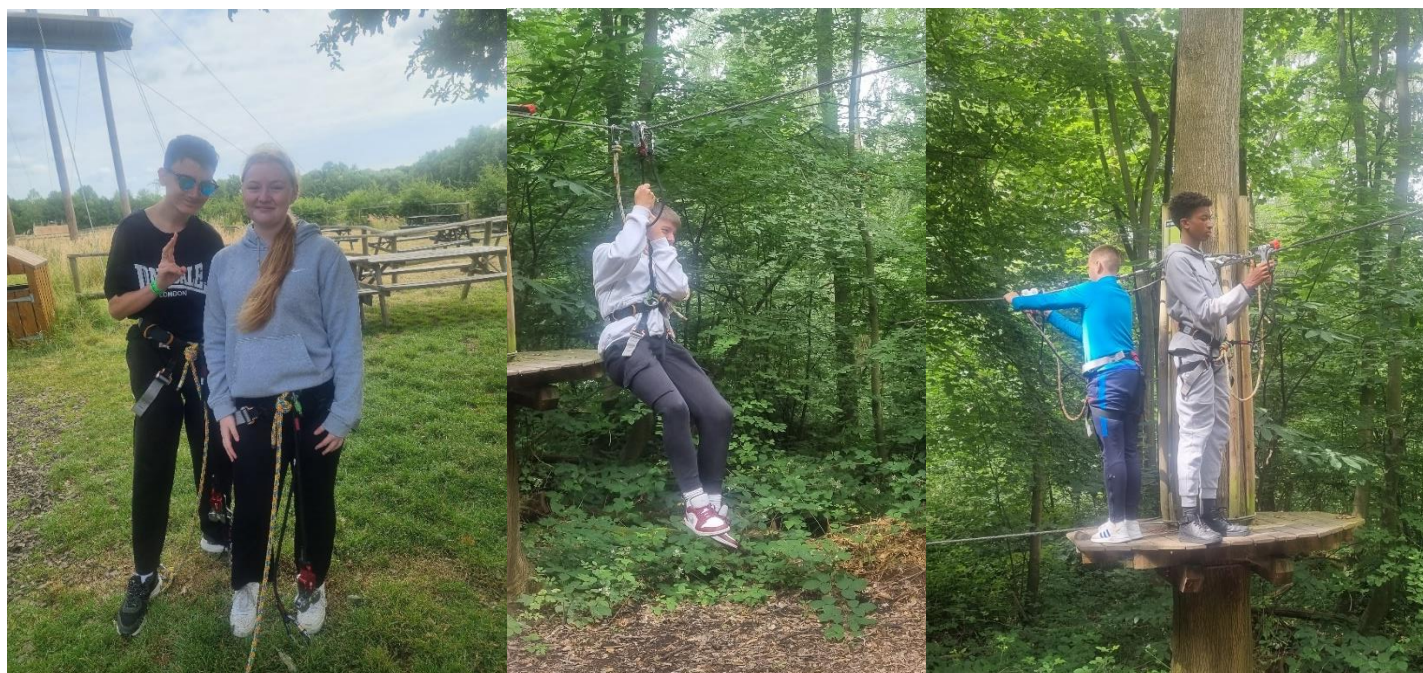
LOST PROPERTY
