EDUCATIONAL VISITS CONSENT

We often take children on local visits in connection with their work in school and for their participation in sporting activities. Each time we do this we have to ask for your consent. To make organisation a little less complicated, please read the information below and then if you consent, tick the relevant box in the Parental Agreement and Consent section.

Visits would normally be on foot, but might be by minibus. We will still inform you if your child is going to be out of school, but with a global consent form there would be no need for you to reply each time.

When visits involve a cost and a voluntary contribution is requested you will receive a letter with a consent form to complete and return.

The consent we are requesting at this time is as follows.

- I wish my child to be involved in local visits and I understand that information regarding these visits will be provided, but unless there are associated costs, I will not be expected to give my consent for each individual visit.
- I further understand that a local visit will not include a residential stay or activities, which could be described as potentially hazardous, for example, rock climbing. In any such case the school will seek my consent on each and every occasion.
- I consent to any emergency medical treatment necessary during the course of a visit.
