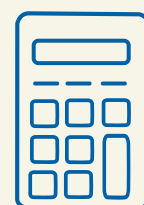

Task ART

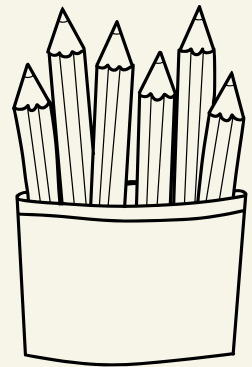
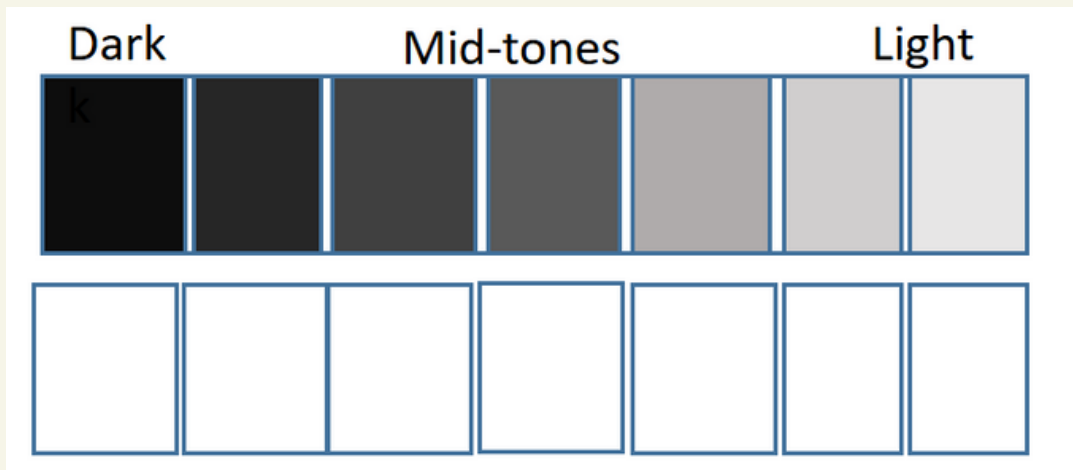
Your Art homework for this term is designed to help you develop your understanding of shade and tone, whilst also improving your drawing skills.

Work carefully shading neatly in the boxes.



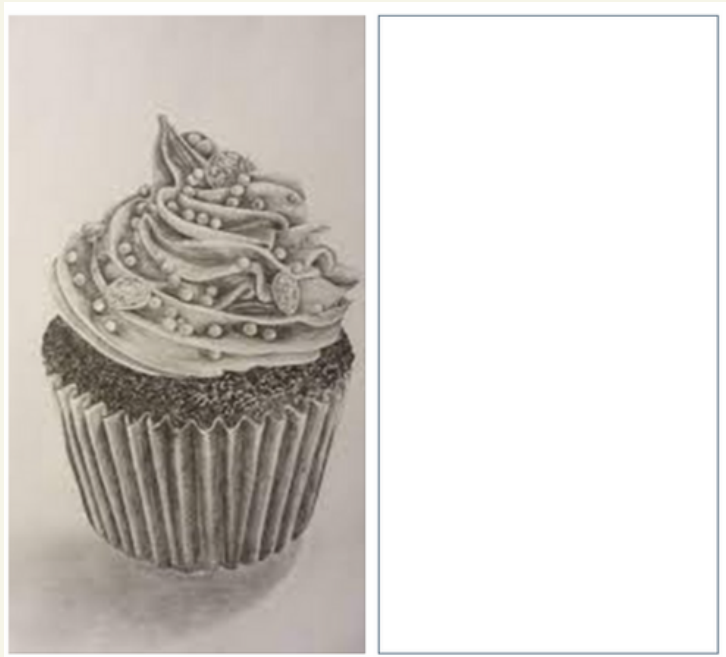
Observation Task

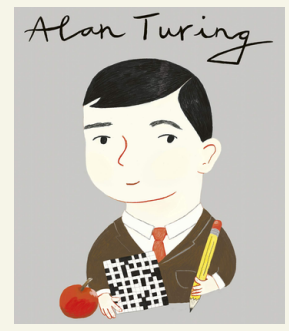
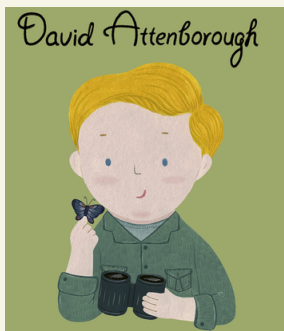
Task HISTORY

You be researching these important people that have shaped the world that we live in.



Activity Instructions

You are going to carry out research into **one** of the House Heroes, you should aim to find out as much as you can about them and what they did/have done that impacts our lives. You should then use your research to create an eye-catching informative infographic that shares key facts about their life and achievements.

Step One : Find out as much as you can about your House Hero (pick one from the list above)

Step Two : Create an infographic (digital or hand-drawn) that includes:

- The name and image (drawing or printed) of your House Hero
- Five interesting or inspiring facts about them
- One question you would ask them if you had the chance to meet them

For example:

Alan Turing (Mathematician and Codebreaker)

Fact - He is known as the father of modern computing.

Question I would ask him- "What inspired you to study machines that could think?"

Remember to make your infographic creative by making it colourful, including plenty of images and interesting information, and make sure it is easy to read.

Instructions:

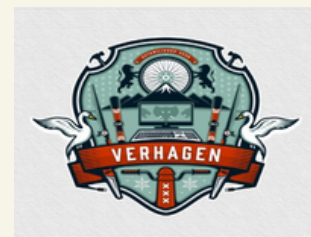
Step 1 On a piece of A4 paper:

Activity Instructions

Step One - Choose one major city that was important to the Silk Roads
(see suggestions below)

Step Two - Carry out independent research into your chosen city using trusted websites

Step Three - Create a basic fact file that includes the following sections:

- Name of the city
- Where the city is located (country and region)
- Why the city was important to the Silk Roads
- What goods were traded through it
- Who lived or passed through the city (e.g. merchants, travellers, rulers)
- One interesting or surprising fact
- A picture or drawing of the city (historical or modern)



Examples of Silk Road Cities to choose from:

Samarkand (Uzbekistan)
Chang'an/Xi'an (China)
Baghdad (Iraq)
Kashgar (China)
Constantinople (Turkey)
Merv (Turkmenistan)
Aleppo or Damascus (Syria)



Presentation Tips:

1. Be creative: add colour, images and maps
2. Make sure information is clear and accurate, and written in your own words
3. Use headings and bullet points to organise your work.

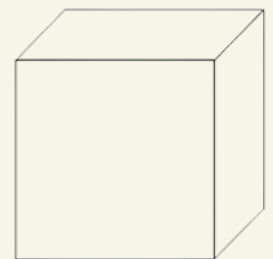
Activity Three

Step One

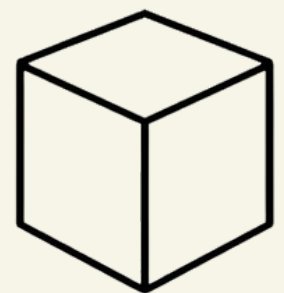
- On an A4 piece of paper draw a 3D cube

Step Two

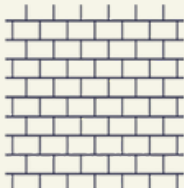
- Use a pencil to carefully add a different pattern to each side of your cube

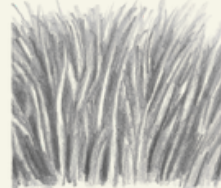

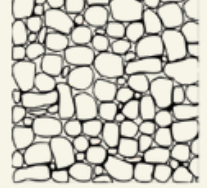
