# Day One

## Monday

### London Exploration or Outdoor Exploration & Creativity \*

#### London Exploration

**Where:** The Science Museum & Hyde Park

**What:** The children will be split into groups (details to follow). The London trip includes:

- Interactive exhibitions at the Science Museum
- Lunch in Hyde Park

**Travel:** Train travel - drop-off and collection at Redhill Station (timings to be confirmed).

**Other info:**

- Full school uniform, trainers are permitted.
- Children should bring a single bag only.
- Bring a packed lunch. Children in receipt of Free School Meals can request a packed lunch by e-mailing [info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk) should they wish to do so.
- Bring a refillable water bottle and weather appropriate items (raincoat, sun lotion)
- The children may bring a small amount of money to spend in the gift shop.

**Cost per child:** £18 via ScoPay

# Day Two Tuesday

## London Exploration or Outdoor Exploration & Creativity \*

### Outdoor Exploration & Creativity

**Where:** Box Hill National Trust (Car Park), Box Hill Road, Tadworth, KT20 7LB

**What:** A day immersed in nature with a guided walk and an outdoor art activity, promoting resilience and appreciation for the environment.

**Travel:** Children to make their own way to and from the location.

- Drop-off: 10:30am at Box Hill Car Park
- Pick-up: 2:30pm from Box Hill Car Park

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable outdoor clothing and prepare for the weather (hat, suncream, raincoat, comfortable footwear).
- Bring a packed lunch. Children in receipt of Free School Meals can request a packed lunch by e-mailing [info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk) should they wish to do so.
- Children may bring a small amount of money for an optional visit to the café for ice cream.
- Bring a refillable water bottle.

**Cost per child:** FREE

# Day Three

## Wednesday

### Choice of Activities

Children will be allocated one of their three preferred choices

#### Option 1: Go Ape & Watersports

**Where:** Tilgate Park, Crawley

**What:** An outdoor and action-packed day where children challenge themselves, work as a team and have fun! Half of the day is spent on the Go Ape high ropes course and the other half is spent on the lakes doing watersports.

**Travel:** Children should arrive at Reigate School at 8:15am. They will travel to and from Tilgate Park via coaches and arrive back at Reigate School at approximately 3:45pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable outdoor clothing and pack for the weather (hat, suncream, raincoat). Please pack a spare pair of clothes including footwear, a swimming costume/trunks for the watersports and a towel.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch and bring plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to [info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk).

**Cost per child:** £42 via ScoPay



## Option 2: Footgolf and Five-a-side

**Where:** Gatwick Footgolf, Horley

**What:** A round of footgolf in the morning, followed by a 5-a side tournament after lunch.

**Travel:** Children are to arrive at Reigate School at 8:30am and will travel to and from Gatwick Footgolf via Reigate school minibuses. Children are expected back into school at 3.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable outdoor clothing and pack for the weather (hat, suncream, raincoat, football boots or astro turf trainers/boots).
- Children should bring a packed lunch and plenty of water. Children may bring a small amount of cash to purchase limited snacks which include chocolate and crisps. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to [info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk).

**Cost per child:** £8 via ScoPay



# Day Three

## Option 3: Emirates Stadium Tour

**Where:** Emirates Stadium, North London

**What:** An exclusive tour of Arsenal's football stadium, including behind-the-scenes access to the dressing room, dugout and trophy room. Experience the view of elite footballers as you make your way through the tunnel and on to the pitch side.

**Travel:** Children will travel to and from London via train and are to arrive at Redhill Station at 9.00am. Children should be collected or make their own way home from Redhill Station at 4.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable clothing and comfortable shoes and bring appropriate clothing for the weather (suncream, hat and a raincoat).
- Children should bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch and bring plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to [info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk](mailto:info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk).

**Cost per child:** £37.50 via ScoPay



# Day Three

## Option 4: Film in a Day

**Where:** Reigate School

**What:** A practical filmmaking workshop that is run by industry experts, putting children behind and in front of the camera as directors, actors, sound producers and stunt co-ordinators. The morning consists of sessions in Film History, Fight Choreography, Camera, Screenwriting and Editing. In the afternoon children will take the 10 Shot Challenge, making short films in groups for screening at their very own OSCARS.

**Travel:** Children to arrive at school for 8.45am and will finish at the normal time of 3.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable own clothes.
- Film making equipment will be provided.

**Cost per child:** £23.50 via ScoPay



# Day Three

## Option 5: Music

**Where:** Reigate School


**What:** Receive musical guidance from industry experts. Write and record your own song or perfect a cover track. Work as a solo artist or in a group.

**Travel:** Children to arrive at school for 8.45am and will finish at the normal time of 3.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable own clothes.
- Musical experience is not required. Instruments will be provided.

**Cost per child:** FREE



## Option 6: Art

**Where:** Reigate School


**What:** Receive artistic guidance from industry experts. Develop your own piece using methods of your choice.

**Travel:** Children to arrive at school for 8.45am and will finish at the normal time of 3.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable own clothes.
- Artistic experience is not required. Supplies will be provided

**Cost per child:** FREE

## Option 7: Board Games

**Where:** Reigate School

**What:** Play with friends, battling it out to see who will be victorious. Or, design and build your own game to play at home.

**Travel:** Children to arrive at school for 8.45am and will finish at the normal time of 3.00pm.

**Other info:**

- Wear suitable own clothes.
- Board games will be provided. Children are welcome to bring games in from home, at their own risk.

**Cost per child:** FREE

**Where:** Reigate School

**What:** Competitive House based events in the morning, followed by an afternoon exploring careers.

**Time:** Children to arrive at school for 9.00am and will finish at the normal time of 3.00pm.
