Leisure Activities

A choice of **one** of the following activities

There is limited capacity in these activities. Please select your preferred 3 activities via the online form.

Option 1: Go Ape and Watersports



Where: Tilgate Park Main Car Park, Tilgate Drive, Tilgate, Crawley, RH10 5PQ

What: This is an outdoor action-packed day where children challenge themselves, work as a team and have fun! Half of the day is spent on the Go Ape high ropes course and the other half is spent on the Lakes doing watersports.

Travel: Children are to arrive at Reigate School at 8:15am and will travel to and from Tilgate Park by coach. Children should be collected or make their own way home from Reigate School at 3:45pm.

Other info:

- Please wear outdoor clothing suitable for the weather to include a hat, suncream and raincoat. Please bring a swimming costume/trunks and a towel for the watersport activities.
- Ensure your child has a spare change of clothes to include footwear.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch and bring plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk.
- Any child who has ordered a packed lunch will be responsible for collecting this from the canteen on the day of the trip.
- If there are any issues regarding the financing of any of the activities and your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, please feel free to contact the Finance Office at <u>finance@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk</u> to see if financial assistance is possible.

Approximate cost per child: £50.00 (we will notify you by e-mail once payments are ready to be processed via ScoPay)

Option 2: Footgolf and 5 a-side





Where: Gatwick Footgolf, Antlands Lane, Horley, RH6 9TF

What: A round of footgolf in the morning, followed by a 5-a side tournament after lunch. Travel: Children are to arrive at Reigate School at 8:30am and will travel to and from Footgolf by Reigate School minibuses. Children are expected back into school at 3.00pm and should be collected or make their own way home.

Other info:

- Please wear outdoor clothing suitable for the weather to include a hat, suncream and raincoat. Children are permitted to bring football boots or astroturfs.
- Children may bring their own football to use or can hire one from the club shop at £1.00 per ball.
- Children should bring a packed lunch and bring plenty of water. Children may bring a small amount of cash to purchase limited snacks which include chocolate bars or crisps. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to <u>info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk</u>. Any child who has ordered a packed lunch will be responsible for collecting this from the canteen on the day of the trip.

Option 3: Sports and Athletics



Where: K2 Leisure Centre, Pease Pottage Hill, Crawley, RH11 9BQ

What: This is both an indoor and outdoor action-packed day where children take part in a variety of sports at an elite training facility. Sports include climbing, athletics, squash and basketball with opportunities for competitions, matches and training.

Travel: Children are to arrive at Reigate School at 8:15am and will travel to and from K2 by coach. Children should be collected or make their own way home from Reigate School at 3:45pm.

Other info:

- Please wear suitable sports clothing and shoes. If you have running shoes for the track, you may bring these. There are locker facilities at the venue which accept a £1.00 coin or alternatively, a trolley coin.
- Bring appropriate clothing for the weather, e.g. suncream, hat, coat, etc.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or money to buy lunch and bring plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk. Any child who has ordered a packed lunch will be responsible for collecting this from the canteen on the day of the trip.
- If there are any issues regarding the financing of any of the activities and your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, please feel free to contact the Finance Office at <u>finance@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk</u> to see if financial assistance is possible.

Option 4: London Stadium Tour



Where: Venue TBC

What: An exclusive tour of a Premier League football stadium to include behind-thescenes access to the dressing room, dugout and trophy room. Experience the view of elite footballers as you make your way through the tunnel and on to the pitch side. **Travel:** Children will travel to and from London via train and are to arrive at Redhill Station at 9.00am. Children should be collected or make their own way home from Redhill Station at 4.00pm.

Other info:

- Wear suitable outdoor clothing and comfortable shoes. Please wear outdoor clothing suitable for the weather to include a hat, suncream and a raincoat.
- Children should bring a packed lunch and bring plenty of water. If your child is eligible for free school meals and would like to have a packed lunch provided by the school, please email your request to info@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk.
- If there are any issues regarding the financing of any of the activities and your child is eligible for pupil premium funding, please feel free to contact the Finance Office at <u>finance@reigate-school.surrey.sch.uk</u> to see if financial assistance is possible.

Option 5: Music and Performing Arts



Where: Reigate School

What: Receive musical guidance from industry experts. Write and record your own song or perfect a cover track. Work as a solo artist or in a group. Travel: Children will be based at Reigate School and are to arrive at 8:45am and depart at 3.00pm.

Other info:

- Please wear Reigate School PE kit.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or alternatively, the canteen will be open with limited choices and availability. Free school meals will be served from the canteen as normal.
- Musical experience is not required. Instruments will be provided.

Option 6: Creative Arts





Where: Reigate School

What: Receive artistic guidance from industry experts. Develop your own piece using methods of your choice.

Travel: Children will be based at Reigate School and are to arrive at 8:45am and depart at 3.00pm.

Other info:

- Please wear Reigate School PE kit.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or alternatively, the canteen will be open with limited choices and availability. Free school meals will be served from the canteen as normal.
- Artistic experience is not required. Supplies will be provided.

Option 7: Board Gaming





What: Play with friends, battling it out to see who will be victorious! Or design and build your own game to play at home.

Travel: Children will be based at Reigate School and are to arrive at 8:45am and depart at 3.00pm.

Other info:

- Please wear Reigate School PE kit.
- Children should bring a packed lunch or alternatively, the canteen will be open with limited choices and availability. Free school meals will be served from the canteen as normal.
- Board games will be provided but children are welcome to bring games in from home, at their own risk.

Where: Reigate School

What: A competitive house-based event in the morning, followed by an afternoon exploring local careers.

Travel: Children are to make their own way to and from school to arrive at 8.45am and depart at 3.00pm

Assault Course & Mud Run



Where: Henfold Lakes, Henfold Lane, Dorking, Surrey, RH5. What 3 Words: ///ozone.saying.goad What: Children will be split into three groups with a set time of arrival and departure. This information will follow in due course. Children will take part in physical outdoor activities which will include the Reigate School famous 'Mud Run' – an assault course with over 100 obstacles and plenty of fun! Travel: Drop-off and collection at Henfold Lakes. Children will be required to arrange their own transport to and from the venue. They will be assigned their own arrival and departure time and this information will follow.

Other info:

- The children should wear old clothes and trainers that they do not mind getting very muddy/wet and that you do not mind being discarded afterwards. A bin bag is recommended for wet/muddy clothes.
- Ensure your child has a complete change of clothes to include footwear and towel(s).
- There are very basic 'refreshing' showers available. The children should bring toiletries if they wish to make use of this facility.
- All clothing should be appropriate for the weather and include a sunhat and suncream.

- This is a requirement by the organisers for all children who are attending the venue whether participating in activities or not. It is essential that it is completed, as your child will not be able to attend or take part without it.
